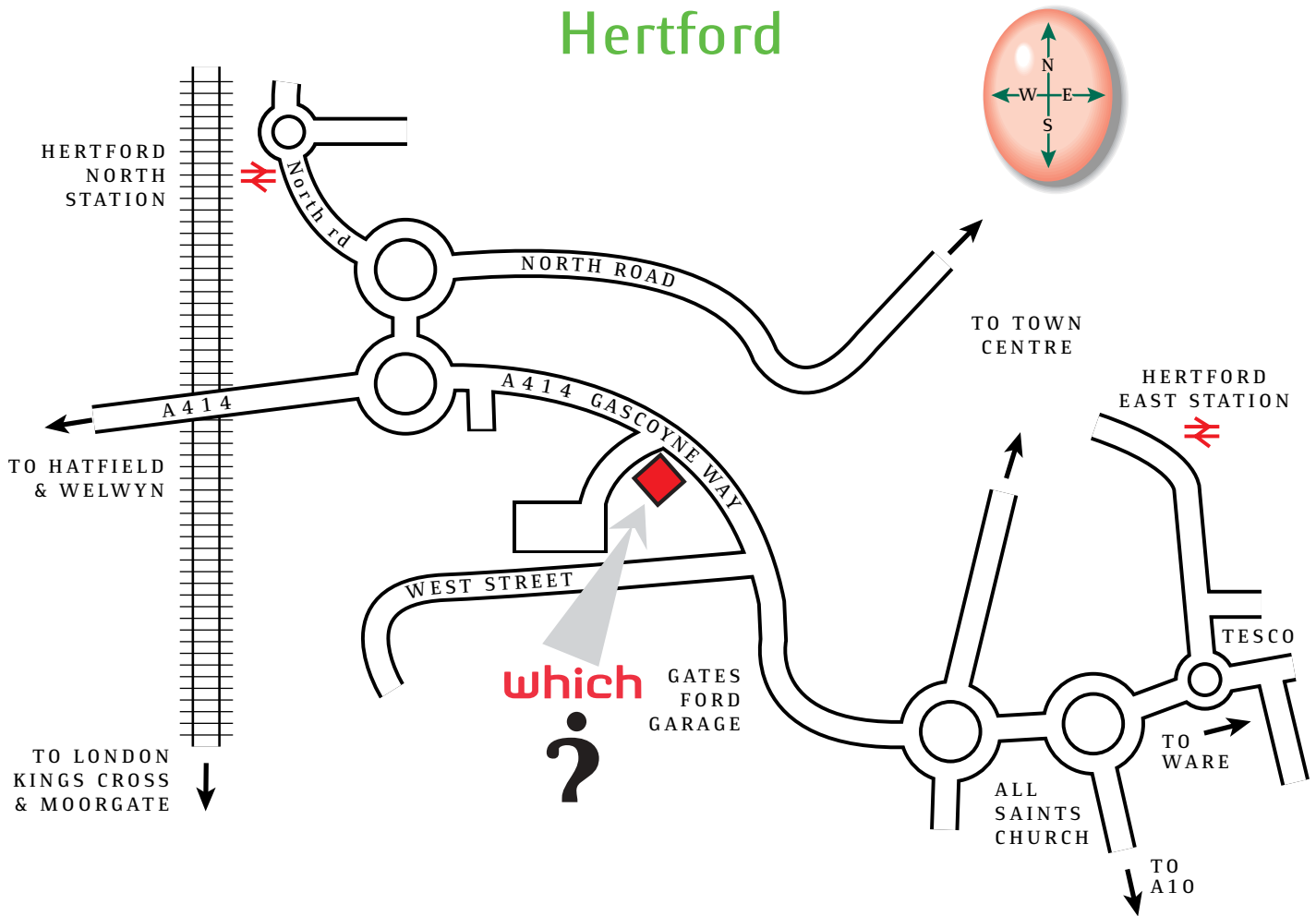

Getting to Hertford

By road

From the **A10**, take the **A414** signposted for Hertford and Hatfield. Follow this road for approximately one mile into Hertford Town Centre. Turn left into Gascoyne Way. The Which? offices are situated on the A414 in Gascoyne Way. This is a dual carriageway and you need to keep in the left lane to get on to the slip road which takes you straight into the visitors' car park at the front of the building.

From the **M25/M1/A1** follow signposts for Hatfield/Hertford A414. The Which? offices are situated on the A414 in Gascoyne Way, this is a dual carriageway. You will see the offices on your right. Drive past the offices to the next roundabout and come back on the left side of the dual carriageway, keeping in the left lane to get on to the slip road which takes you straight into the visitors' car park at the front of the building.

By rail

From **Kings Cross** to **Hertford North**, you may need to change at Finsbury Park. Trains run approximately every 15 to 20 minutes at peak times. Maximum journey time 50 minutes. Taxis are available at the station.

To walk from the station to the Which? offices, come out of the station and turn right, cross over the road at the pelican crossing. Continue on, you will see the Hertford County Hospital on your right, keep going straight on, past Waters Garage on your right.

Cross over the road immediately after the garage and proceed through the underpass (Hertford Antiques shop will be on your left). At the end, turn right, come out of underpass and you will be outside the Which? offices. Time approximately 10 minutes

From **Liverpool Street** to **Hertford East**, you may need to change at Broxbourne. Trains run approximately every 15 to 20 minutes at peak times. Maximum journey time one hour. Taxis are available at the station.

To walk from the station to the Which? offices, come out of the station on to Mill Road. Cross the road and past the Dolphin public house, take the third turning on the right into Railway Street (the Lord Haig public house will be facing you). This road takes you through Hertford town. Carry straight on past various shops and banks (Lloyds and Barclays), you will come to a pedestrianised area (Maidenhead Street). At the end you will see a pelican crossing. Cross over and turn right, the Castle Hall will be in front of you. Carry straight on, down St Andrew Street, bearing left after a set of traffic lights. Walk past St Andrews Church on the left, you will then come to an underpass (Hertford Antiques shop will be on your left). Proceed through the underpass. At the end, turn right, come out of underpass. You will then be outside the Which? offices. Time approximately 15 minutes.

Parking
